North Tapps Middle School is a great place to learn and play. From our four state of the art science labs to our regular classrooms outfitted with up-to-date technology and features, NTMS is suited for a quality education in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. We have two gymnasiums, a modern fitness room, large commons area, a football/soccer field, track, fastpitch/baseball fields, tennis courts, and 1:1 ratio of personal computers for students and staff. A big thank you goes out to our community for supporting us with such great facilities and programs for our students.

We educated approximately 527 students in grades 6 through 8 throughout the 2017-18 school year. NTMS had 25 classroom teachers that have an average of 19.6 years experience. Approximately 72% of those teachers have Master's Degrees. Seven of 25 certificated teachers are National Board Certified.

Our staff and students benefit greatly from our Academic, Collaboration and Enhancement (ACE) time. We are more than ever in dire need of our ACE time for teachers to plan together, receive professional development and communicate with parents.

Here at North Tapps communication with our families and community is of the utmost importance. We send out weekly newsletters, and grades can be accessed on Schoology. We post current information on our reader board and school website. We also have Family Access and Schoology information on our website available for instant student information.

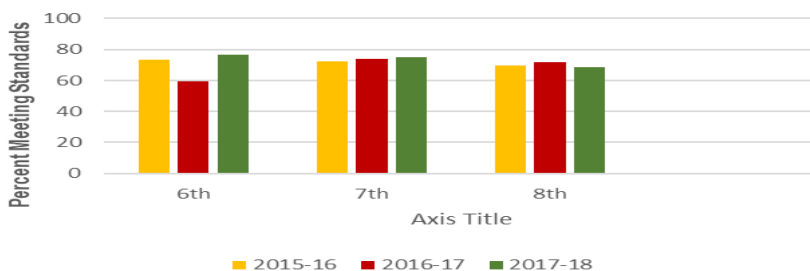

### STUDENT LEARNING IMPROVEMENT DAYS

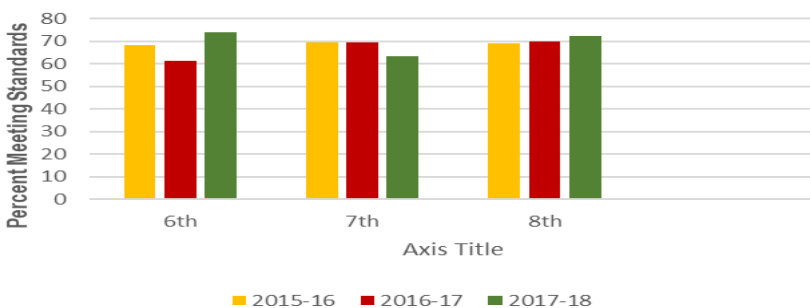

- ◆ Differentiated learning

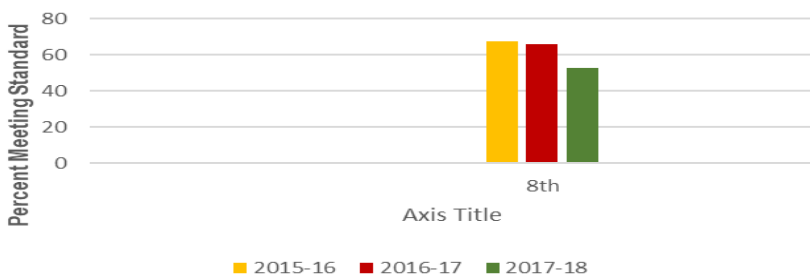

#### Math



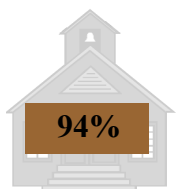
